## Programs

**LINCS** continues to partner with other non-profit agencies in applying for collaborative grants that would provide services to unique populations.

**The North Fork Alliance** strives to reduce substance abuse among local youth, to build awareness among parents and other adults about the substance abuse problem in the North Fork area, and to strengthen collaboration among high-need isolated North Fork area neighborhoods, private non-profits, media outlets, religious institutions, businesses, parents, the Federal government, NY State, and Suffolk County by fortifying comprehensive prevention coordination. Partnering in these efforts are the Long Island Association for AIDS Care, Inc. (LIAAC) and the Suffolk Coalition to Prevent Alcohol and Drug Dependency (SCPADD).
